Protecting Your Financial Security

How to Avoid the Latest Identity Scams

News about data compromises, personal identity theft and a host of other personal finance security and privacy concerns are on the rise. We'd like to remind our members that we are diligent about protecting your personal information and that you can help us protect your financial security by considering the following.

1. E-mails pretending to be from the IRS are particularly rampant this tax season. If you get an e-mail promising that you are due a tax refund and/or soliciting your social security number, it is likely a hoax. If you doubt the authenticity of any communication from the IRS, contact them to confirm its legitimacy.
2. Do not supply your social security number, PIN or account number(s) to anyone without verifying the source. It is an invitation to identity theft. We NEVER solicit your social security number or account number(s) either by surface mail, by phone or by e-mail. If you receive a communication that appears to be from us asking for this sensitive information, please contact us immediately.
3. Recently, many consumers have had their financial information compromised by merchants. Before using your credit or debit card with a merchant, make sure that it is a reputable business that has your financial safety in mind. If you ever have concerns about trusting a merchant with your credit card account number or checking account number, pay by cash or money order or shop elsewhere. If your financial information is compromised by a merchant, we will notify you immediately and begin procedures to protect your accounts.
4. If you ever suspect that your account information or other personal information has been compromised, contact us immediately at (978) 851-9750, ext. 104 so we can take appropriate steps to safeguard your accounts.
